



# Findon Riding Club Summer Show

## Ring 1 - Working Hunter Classes

**Judge – Jane Gilchrist**

**Starts 9.00 am**

**Class 1 Green Working Hunter Horse**

Over 15hh or 153cm (fences max 70cm). For horses never to have been placed in a novice or above Working Hunter or Hunter Trials or One Day Event and to have no BSJA winnings.

**Class 2 Novice Working Hunter Horse**

Over 15hh or 153cm (fences max 85cm). For horses never to have been placed in an open Working Hunter class and not to have more than £50 BSJA winnings.

**Class 3 Eastern BMW/BHS Scotland Riding Club Working Hunter Series 2018**

**Eligibility:** Horses must be 15hh and over. Horses must not have won more than £400 in total in any WH competitions, more than £400 in BS winnings or have more than 45 BE points. Riders must be 18yo or over on 1 Jan 2018

**Course:** You will be asked to jump a course of 8-12 fences approx 3'3" in height.

Classes will be judged in line with Sport Horse Breeding Society of GB rules.

**Qualification:** The first three partnerships will qualify for the final even if they did not jump clear. If one of the first three has already qualified, their qualification can be passed down to the fourth placed horse and rider provided they jumped clear. To be eligible for the final, the rider must be a member of a riding club affiliated to BRC.

**Class 4 Dodson & Horrell/BHS Scotland Working Hunter Series 2018**

**Eligibility:** Horses must be 15hh or over, 4 years old and over. Riders must be 18 years old or over. To compete at the final, either the rider or owner of the horse must be a member of the BHS.

**Course:** 8-12 fences approx 3'6", judged in line with Sports Horse GB rules.

**Qualifying:** The first three partnerships will qualify even if they have not jumped clear. If one of these has already qualified, their qualification may be handed down to the fourth placed horse and rider provided they had a clear round.

**Working Hunter Championship for classes 1–4 will take place after class 4  
1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners will be eligible**

- Class 5 60/70cms Working Hunter Pony**  
153cm and under. Open to any combination never to have been placed in an Open or Intermediate Working Hunter Class
- Class 6 80cms Working Hunter Pony**  
153cm and under. Open to any combination never to have been placed in an Open Working Hunter class
- Class 7a 90cms Open Working Hunter Pony**  
153cms and under
- Class 7b Blair Castle Working Hunter Pony Series**  
Not exceeding 133cms – Min height 75cms Max height 90cms
- Class 8 Blair Castle Working Hunter Pony Series**  
133 cms – 143cms - Min height 85cms Max height 1m
- Class 9 Blair Castle Working Hunter Pony series**  
143cms – 153cms Min height 90cms Max height 1.05m

**Blair Castle Working Hunter Pony Series 2018**  
**Run under BPS Rules Full Rules in BPS Handbook**  
**Ponies 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> will qualify for Blair Final on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2018**  
**Qualification may go down to 6<sup>th</sup> if higher places previously qualified.**

**Working Hunter Championship for classes 5 – 8 will take place after class 9**  
**1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners will be eligible**

## Ring 2 - Ridden Classes Judge – Ian Duncan

**Starts 9.30am**

- Class 10 Junior Equitation 17yrs & under**  
Trophy to highest placed Findon Member & Trophy for highest place Findon member under 11 years.
- Class 11 Riding Club Pony**  
Ponies 14.2hh (148cm) and under to be ridden in a snaffle bridle with no martingale or spurs. Competitors will be asked to jump a fence.
- Class 12 Ridden Veteran –**  
Open to horses and ponies aged 16 and over.
- Class 13 Senior Equitation**  
18yrs & over Trophy to Highest Placed Findon Member.
- Class 14 Riding Club Horse**  
Horses over (148cm) 14.2hh to be ridden in a snaffle bridle with no martingale or spurs. Competitors will be asked to jump a fence

**Championship for classes 10-14 will take place after class 14 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners will be eligible**

## Ring 2

**Approx start 1pm**

- Class 15 Ridden Coloured (Includes Palomino/Appaloosa)**  
Open to horses and ponies 4 years old and over. Unrestricted height
- Class 16 Ridden Mountain & Moorland (may be split small & large)**  
Open to Pure and part bred - Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fell, Highlands, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Sections A,B,C,D.
- Class 17 Ridden Cob**  
4 years old and over. Unrestricted height, to be shown natural or hogged and trimmed.
- Class 18 Ridden Sports Horse**  
Open to horses exceeding 148cms (14.2hh)

**Championship for classes 15 -18 will take place after class 18 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners will be eligible**

### 3 - Ridden Class

**Starts 10:00 am**

**Judge – Lesley Campbell**

- Class 19 Ridden Clydesdale Qualifier for Blair Castle on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> August 18**  
To be judged as a Ridden Hunter class. First two horses will qualify  
Qualification may go down to 4<sup>th</sup> place if horses placed 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> have already qualified.
- Class 20 Novice Ridden Horse**  
Mare or gelding, 4yrs or over exceeding 148cms(14.2hh). To be shown in snaffle bridles only. Horse/rider combination not to have won any ridden showing class. Riders any age. There will be no canter in the go round. The judge will not ride.
- Class 21 Riding Horse & Ridden Hacks**  
Open to horses over 148cms (14.2hh)
- Class 22 Side Saddle**  
Open to any horse/pony rider combination
- Class 23 Ridden Pure/Part/Anglo Arab**  
Open to horses and ponies age 4 and over. Will be split Pure/Part bred if entries permit
- Class 24 Small Hunter**  
Open to horses between 148cms (14.2hh) and 158cms (15.3hh)
- Class 25 Ridden Hunter**  
Open to horses exceeding 158cms (15.3hh)  
Class may be split if entries allow.  
Please specify on entry form if light, Middle or Heavyweight.

**Championship for classes 18–24 will take place after class 24 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners will be eligible**

**All Champions and Reserve Champions from Arenas 1, 2 & 3 will be eligible for the Overall Championship which will be held in Ring 3 after all Rings are finished**

### **Rules and regulations**

1. Rosettes will be awarded for 1st to 6th place.
2. Ages are as at 1st January 2018.
3. Horses/Ponies must be four years old or over.
4. Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 7 and 8 will be judged 60% on jumping style and performance and 40% for conformation. No change of saddlery will be permitted throughout the competition. Any suitable bridle may be worn although we would prefer 4 year olds to be shown in a snaffle.
5. If in the event of there being large entries in the Working Hunter classes, horse/pony and rider combinations may be restricted to entering one Working Hunter class only.
6. The committee reserves the right to alter, divide or cancel any of the classes, and to transfer entries, which in their opinion are in the wrong class, with or without giving a reason.
7. Findon Riding Club will not be held responsible for any complaint regarding horses or ponies entered in the wrong class, but will act as a mediator provided the complainant has proof on the day of the show.

8. At or in the vicinity of any Findon Riding Club event, everyone mounted, whether competing or not must wear a hard hat conforming to the minimum safety standards, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination of the horse and/or rider from the competition. Hats must be marked to standard as per BRC rules. Where a hat is of skull cap style, this must be worn with a plain silk.
9. The wearing of body protectors is recommended.
10. Disclaimer of liability – save for death or personal injury caused by negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor the agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
11. Dogs must be kept on leads **at all times**.
12. The making of an entry implies acceptance of the conditions listed above.
