## **Ring 1 - Working Hunter Classes**

**Judge – Mrs Mary Buchan**

**Starts 10.00 am**

**Class 1 50cms Open Working Hunter Horse or Pony**

**Class 2 60cms Open Working Hunter Horse or Pony**

**Class 3 70cms Open Working Hunter Horse or Pony**

**Class 4 80cms Open Working Hunter Horse or Pony**

**Class 5 90cms Open Working Hunter Horse or Pony**

**Class 6 1m Open Working Hunter Horse or Pony**

**Class 7 1m 10 Open Working Hunter Horse or Pony**

- Classes are open to all horses and ponies (maybe split if entries are large)- horse distances will apply.
- Classes will be judged 60% on jumping style and performance and 40% on conformation & show.
- No change of saddlery will be allowed between phases.
- Any suitable bridle maybe worn although we would prefer 4year olds to be shown in a snaffle.
- The judge will not ride, competitors will be asked to do a short show.
- No horse/pony will be stripped for confirmation in the Ridden classes.

## **Working Hunter Championship for all 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winner**

**Ring 2 – In –Hand classes**

**Starts 09:30am**

**Judge – Mr John Karwl- Jackes**

**Class 8 Best Turned Out – In Hand – Open to all Plaited/unplaited** – Class will be judged on correctness of turn out for type. Due to Physical distancing measures the judge may not inspect tack or touch any horse/pony but will judge overall appearance from initial walk round and then from a walk around each horse, pony & handler.

**Class 9 In Hand Youngstock** - yearling, 2- or 3-year olds (**maybe split into pony/horse depending on numbers**)

**Class 10 In Hand Pony:** Open to all breeds/types. 4 years old and over, not to exceed 148cm/14.2hh.

**Class 11 In Hand Horse** Open to all breeds/types exceeding 153cms/15hh 4 years old and over.

**Class 12 In Hand Veteran** 15 years and over. Any type, to be judged on confirmation, movement, condition & soundness. Will be split by age/height if there are sufficient entries.

**Class 13 In Hand Mountain & Moorland** Open to Pure and part bred - Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fell, Highlands, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Sections A, B,C,D.

**Class 14 Young Handler** – 16 years & under

Any type, age, size of horse/pony. Class will be judged on presentation, turnout & showing skills of the handler, conformation and movement of the horse will not be taken into account.

**In Hand Championship for classes 8 -14 after class 14 ,all 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners will be eligible**

**Ring 2 - Ridden Classes**  
**Judge Mr John Karwl Jackes**

**Starts 1.00pm**

**Class 15 Ridden Best Turned Out** Class will be judged on correctness of turn out for type. Due to Physical distancing measures the judge may not inspect tack or touch any horse/pony but will judge overall appearance from initial walk round and then from a walk around each horse, pony & rider.

**Class 16 Junior Equitation 17yrs & under (including lead rein)**

Trophy to highest placed Findon Member & Trophy for highest place Findon member under 11 years.

**Class 17 Riding Club Pony**

Ponies 14.2hh (148cm) and under to be ridden in a snaffle bridle with no martingale or spurs. Competitors will be asked to jump a fence. Riders any age.

**Class 18 Riding Club Horse**

Horses over (148cm) 14.2hh to be ridden in a snaffle bridle with no martingale or spurs. Competitors will be asked to jump a fence.

**Class 19 Senior Equitation**

18yrs & over Trophy to Highest Placed Findon Member.

**Class 20 Ridden Veteran** – Open to horses and ponies aged 16 and over.

**Class 21 Ridden Mountain & Moorland (may be split small & large)**

Open to Pure and part bred - Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fell, Highlands, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Sections A, B,C,D.

**Class 22 Ridden Horses 14hh& over**

Open to Hunters, Hack, Arabs, coloured and cobs (class maybe split depending on numbers)

**Championship for classes 14 –22 will take place after class 22  
1st and 2nd prize winners will be eligible**

### **Rules and regulations**

**Due to on going Covoid measures we ask that all those attending ensure they maintain physical distancing and sanitise their hands regularly- during classes horses/ponies will be lined up with at least 1m space between them.**

**Whilst every due care will be taken the organisers take no responsibility for the health and safety of any competitor/groom/judge/steward/attendees before, during or after the show. Anyone who has any symptom that might be Covoid related or feels at all unwell or have been in contact with anyone with or suspected of having Covoid 19 to stay at home.**

1. Rosettes will be awarded for 1st to 6th place.
2. Ages are as of 1st January 2021.
3. Horses/Ponies for Ridden Classes must be four years old or over.
4. Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 7, 8&9 will be judged 60% on jumping style and performance and 40% for conformation. No change of saddlery will be permitted throughout the competition. Any suitable bridle may be worn although we would prefer 4-year olds to be shown in a snaffle.
5. If in the event of there being large entries in the Working Hunter classes, horse/pony and rider combinations may be restricted to entering one Working Hunter class only.
6. The committee reserves the right to alter, divide or cancel any of the classes, and to transfer entries, which in their opinion are in the wrong class, with or without giving a reason.
7. Findon Riding Club will not be held responsible for any complaint regarding horses or ponies entered in the wrong class but will act as a mediator provided the complainant has proof on the day of the show.
8. At or in the vicinity of any Findon Riding Club event, everyone mounted, whether competing or not must wear a hard hat conforming to the minimum safety standards, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination of the horse and/or rider from the competition. Hats must be marked to standard as per BRC rules. Where a hat is of skull cap style, this must be worn with a plain silk.
9. The wearing of body protectors is recommended.
10. Disclaimer of liability – save for death or personal injury caused by negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor the agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
11. Dogs must be kept on leads **at all times**.
12. The making of an entry implies acceptance of the conditions listed above.
