The Championship will take place after class 7. 1st and 2nd prize winners will be eligible

General Rules

1. Rosettes will be awarded for 1st to 6th place.
2. Classes are open to horses and ponies – please note that horse distances will apply. All classes are open to all.
3. Classes will be judged 60% on jumping style and performance and 40% for conformation and show. No change of saddlery will be permitted throughout the competition. Any suitable bridle may be worn although we would prefer 4 year olds to be shown in a snaffle. Horse boots/bandages should be removed if you are asked by the judge to come back into the arena for the showing section of the class. Spurs are permitted.
4. The judge WILL NOT be riding any horse or pony. Competitors will be asked to do a short show. Horses WILL NOT be stripped for the conformation part of the class.
5. The committee reserves the right to alter, divide or cancel any of the classes and to transfer entries, which in their opinion are in the wrong class, with or without giving a reason.
6. Findon Riding Club will not be held responsible for any complaint regarding horses or ponies entered in the wrong class, but will act as a mediator provided the complainant has proof on the day of the show.
7. At or in the vicinity of any Findon Riding Club event, everyone mounted, whether competing or not, must wear a hard hat conforming to the minimum safety standards, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination of the horse and/or rider from the competition. Due a change by the European Commission regarding BSEN1384 no longer being an accepted standard, all hats which only meet this and no other standard WILL NOT be accepted and therefore will not be permitted for any BRC competition. A BRC Official Steward or Area Representative can check this for you if you are unsure and can issue any hats which comply with the new regulations with a hat tag. It is the riders responsibility to ensure that they are riding with hats of the correct standard.

These hats are mandatory for any events, training or activities run under the BRC insurance.

All skull cap style hats must be worn with a silk.
8. The wearing of body protectors is recommended.
9. Beagler hats are not permitted.
10. The use of HEAD CAMS are strictly prohibited at any BRC affiliated competition. This includes on the head, chest, bridle or any other part of the horse or rider.
11. Disclaimer of liability – save for death or personal injury caused by negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor the agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
12. The making of an entry implies acceptance of the conditions listed above.
