**Class 1      60cm Team Challenge**

BE 91 Dressage Test (2009)

2 phases of jumping, Fences max 65cm, XC (rustic) fences 60cm, SJ max 65cms

XC time 350mpm

Horse and rider combination must not have been placed in 80cms show jumping or working hunter

**Class 2      70cm Team Challenge**

BE 91 Dressage Test (2009)

2 phases of jumping, SJ Fences max 75cm, XC (rustic) fences 70cm, SJ max 75cm

XC time 350 mpm.

Horse and rider combination must not have been placed in 90cms show jumping or working hunter

**Class 3      80cm Team Challenge**

BE 95 Dressage Test (2012)

2 phases of jumping, SJ Fences max 85cm, XC (rustic) fences 80cm,max85cm,.

XC time 350 mpm.

**Class 4      90cm Team Challenge**

BE 95 Dressage Test (2012)

2 phases of jumping, SJ Fences max 95cm, XC (rustic) fences 90cm, SJ max 95cm

XC time 375 mpm.

**Class 6      1m Open Challenge**

BE95 Dressage Test (2012)

2 phases of jumping, SJ Fences max 1.05m, XC (rustic) fences 1m, SJ max 1.05,

XC time 375 mpm.

## **Rules and regulations**

### **Rules as per BRC 2019**

#### **Hats**

It is mandatory for all competitors to wear a protective helmet at all times when mounted. It must bear the CE mark **and** a quality symbol, either the BSI Kitemark, the SAI Global symbol or the official Snell label with number.

We reserve the right to refuse entries if we feel that you are ineligible for a particular class.

Each team can be made up of three or four members. The three best scores will count from each round. If you are eliminated you will be given a score of the highest penalties from that round + 25, so that your team will have a score.

Classes are open to Horses and Ponies – Horse distances will apply

Competitors can wear show jackets or xc colours, no jumps will be fixed

The wearing of body protectors is recommended

The competition will consist of a Dressage Test followed immediately by a course of approx. 8 show jumps including a double. This will be followed by a timed phase with 6 – 8 Rustic fences which may include a bounce, angle, corner, skinny etc

Each competitor will have approx. 10 mins between Dressage & Jumping phases to have a warm up jump

The competitor will complete the Dressage section and move onto the jumping phase course and will proceed immediately into the Rustic phase, Show jumping starts with a whistle, competitors continue to the first Working Hunter, fence timing will start on passing the start marker and stop on completing the Rustic phase.

The penalties will be scored as per table below for both show jumping and cross country phases. In the event of equal scores, the Team nearest the optimum time will take the higher placing

<b>Penalties for each section (SJ &amp; WH)</b>	
Knockdown	4 penalties
1 <sup>st</sup> disobedience	4 penalties
2 <sup>nd</sup> disobedience	8 penalties
3 <sup>rd</sup> disobedience	Elimination
Fall of rider	8 penalties
2 <sup>nd</sup> fall of rider	Elimination
Fall of Horse	Compulsory Retirement
Retaking an obstacle already jumped	Elimination
Every commenced second in excess of time allowed	1 penalty
Exceeding time limit (3 x time allowed)	Elimination

In the event of equal scores, the Team closest to the optimum time will take the higher placing.

The committee reserves the right to alter, divide or cancel any of the classes, and to transfer entries, which in their opinion are in the wrong class, with or without giving a reason.

Findon Riding Club will not be held responsible for any complaint regarding horses or ponies entered in the wrong class, but will act as a mediator provided the complainant has proof on the day of the show.

At or in the vicinity of any Findon Riding Club event, everyone mounted, whether competing or not must wear a hard hat conforming to the minimum safety standards, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination of the horse and/or rider from the competition. Hats marked PAS 015 or prefixed with ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard allowed. Recommended hard hats should carry the quality assurance stamp of Kitemark or SEI. American standard SNELL E95 and Australian/New Zealand standard SNZ 3838 1998 are also acceptable. Where a hat is of skull cap style, this must be worn with a silk.
